Mount Forest Rams Minor Hockey Tournament Playing Rules

- 1. All teams should report to the tournament convenor to Sign-In at least 45 minutes prior to their first game.
- 2. Teams must be prepared to go on the ice 15 minutes prior to scheduled start times.
- 3. Teams must be ready to go on the ice immediately after the preceding game even if it finishes early.
- 4. Flood at the end of every game.
- 5. There will be a (3) minute warm-up period.
- 6. OMHA rules shall apply, including coach & trainer certification, and Suspensions.
- 7. Games will consist of (3) 10-10-10 periods. Consolation and Championship games will be 10-10-15 periods.
- 8. Ties will be broken in all games and championship games. Overtime will be as follows:
- α . One 5 minute sudden victory period will be played.
- β . If no goal is scored in the first 5 minutes, then a 5 player shootout will occur.
- χ . If still tied after the 5 shooters then 3 shooters will be selected. This is sudden victory. Shooters must be different than first 5 shooters. You are not allowed to reuse shooters until roster has been completed.
- 9. Tournament Convenor will invoke a mercy rule at any time during the game when a team is ahead by 5 goals. The referee will inform each coach that the remainder of regulation time will be played in straight time until the goal differential is less than 5 goals.
- 10. A player or team official who is suspended in a tournament game shall commence serving the suspension in the next following tournament game. If the suspension is fully served before the tournament is over, the player or team official may participate in any remaining tournament games and there will be No carryover of the suspension in league play. Any remaining unserved game suspensions shall then be carried over to his team's first scheduled game following the tournament. Whether league, league playoffs or OMHA (group) play downs.
- 11. In the case of conflicting sweaters, The home team will change
- 12. The home team will be listed first on the official tournament schedule.
- 13. The tournament convenor will have final say concerning eligibility of player and applicability of tournament rules should a dispute arise.
- 14. Each team is guaranteed (2) tournament games.
